Background to Organisation

Signal was formed five years ago when two organisations, the Shropshire Deafness Association (SDA) and the Woodford Foundation joined together. Signal has been operating in one form or another since the 1860s providing assistance to deaf and hard of hearing people within Shropshire. It has been active for fourteen years assisting sensory impaired (deaf and deafblind) children and young people in sub-Saharan Africa to become full and active members of their families and communities.

Introduction to Role

We are seeking a committed individual who is creative and industrious, with experience and qualifications in accounting principles. You will need to work independently and in a fast-paced environment and show initiative in designing and implementing new systems. You should have experience of working with budgets and database, and have excellent IT & analytical skills. Good knowledge of Excel is essential as is the ability to identify trends and spot errors. Working as part of a small team in the charity sector you should be willing to assist with tasks outside of your role and occasionally assist with events where required.

In return you will have the opportunity to work in a growing international development and local charity while gaining valuable experience in the not-for-profit sector.
